I believe we have a proven track record of giving juniors a positive introduction to adult cricket, and this being blocked by people who barely know the junior players or those taking responsibility has been a source of tremendous frustration.

We have also had success giving opportunities to play cricket to people returning to the game, and some adults who have never taken part in competitive cricket. This is something we should also be incredibly proud of. As captain, I am to maintain this to help to grow our club and the sport as a whole in our town.

On the last game of the season one of our talented juniors took the captaincy for the game and was able to show real grit, and tactical skill as well as developing conversation and leadership skills. This is yet another achievement that our 5th XI as a whole should be very proud of. It is fantastic to see us operate as a team and everyone get behind and support the captain, whoever that may be.

Finally, a huge thanks must go to Stuart Peters for supporting me with so much of the off the field admin and tasks, and supporting every player who sets foot on the field for Poole Town cc.
